



APPLICATION FOR SECTION INTERNATIONALE BRITANNIQUE OVERSEAS APPLICATIONS

All children who apply for a place in the *Section Internationale Britannique* take Written and Oral Entrance Tests to establish whether or not they have an appropriate level of English for this bilingual program. As you are currently resident outside of France, it is obviously impractical for your son/daughter to attend the Entrance Test session on Wednesday 18th March 2020. Therefore, in order to consider him/her for a place, we would like you to send us the following as quickly as possible, and certainly by **7th February 2020**.

- 1) The correctly filled in application form.
- <u>Two pieces of extended writing in English</u>, marked by your child's current English or class teacher. Examples of extended writing are stories, diary entries, newspaper or magazine articles or autobiographical accounts. The work should have been written and marked since September 2018.
- 3) Your child's <u>school reports or "dossier scolaire"</u> for the 2018 2019 academic year and for the first term of the current 2020 2021 academic year.
- 4) A <u>report</u> on your child's performance in spoken and written English from his/her current English or class teacher.

Following the receipt of your application form accompanied by these items we will assess whether your child has an appropriate level of written English for admission to the *Section Internationale Britannique*. If your child does have this level, we will contact you to arrange for a written examination to be carried out at your child's current school. Please provide a contact email for someone at your child's school who would be willing to supervise this examination. You should also note that there is no oral examination.
