

Dear members,

Here is the latest update on our weekly Wednesday pm lesson provision that will start next **Wednesday 16/09**.

I am very pleased and relieved to announce that we have found **two** school sites to welcome our students.

As mentioned in my last message, our upper and lower groups will have to be taught separately and will start at different times to facilitate commuting between the two sites for families with more than one child in our scheme.

Please read the instruction below very carefully as both institutions and national guidelines impose very strict Covid-related health and safety protocols that our teachers, helpers, students and parents need to respect at all times. Should anyone not abide by those rules, we may lose the right to use those premises and would have to switch to an online provision.

CM1 and CM2 classes

- **All CM1 and CM2 students will be taught in Collège-Lycée Victor Hugo.** Boulevard Victor Hugo, 31770 Colomiers.
- Students and parents will need to arrive on time for the usual **1pm start**. Pupils will be welcome by their teacher and by myself on the parvis/yard outside the lycée's main entrance.
- Students will be asked to line up with their teacher so that their temperature can be taken. Any student with 38°C (or more) temperature will not be allowed to enter the school site and will have to be taken home.
- Students will need to be collected at the usual time: **3.30pm**.

CP, CE1, CE2 classes

- **All CP, CE1 and CE2 students will be taught at Collège Ste Thérèse in Colomiers**
- Students will need to arrive at **1.30pm** (instead of 1pm).
- The entrance to the school that we will use is **Place du Cantal** and **not via Rue de l'Eglise**. *(see map attached)*
- There is plenty of space to park your car there. See map below.
- Students will be welcome by Sam Backhouse and a teacher. Both will welcome pupils at the gate and will take their temperature. Any student with 38°C (or more) temperature will not be allowed to enter the school site and will have to be taken home.
- Students will need to be collected at **4pm** (instead of 3.30) Place du Cantal.

COVID RELATED PROTOCOL AND PRACTICAL INFORMATION

- If your child's school/class has been shut down, please respect the quarantine imposed and do not bring your child to our weekly lessons until he/she is allowed back to his/her school. Should your child be in quarantine, please let us know and we will ensure that some work gets set.
- Please check your child's temperature every Wednesday before bringing him/her to us and make sure that he/she stays at home if temperature is 38°C or more. This will help avoid any unnecessary delay.

- Parents are not allowed to enter the school site and have to stand aside away from staff and children and wait until their child's temperature has been checked before they can leave.
- Students, parents and siblings all have to wear a mask within a 30-meter radius.
- Students and staff will have to wear their mask at all times while onsite, including during lesson and break time.
- Students and staff will have to disinfect their hands on the way in and on the way out using the antibacterial gel provided at the school gate.
- Students must have their own equipment as they will not be able to borrow stationary from their peers.
- All the classrooms that will be used by English 31 staff and students will all be cleaned (across both sites) before we use them.
- Breaktimes will be staggered to avoid having all children on at the same time.
- Students from one class will not be allowed to mix with students from other classes.
- When picking up students, parents will be asked to respect social distancing and not to gather at the lycée's and school main gate but away from it to allow enough space for our staff and students.

We do not know what the near future holds and whether or not our partner schools will have to shut down their site. We obviously depend on those institutions and should closures affect our Wednesday afternoon lessons; we would have to switch to an online provision until the site(s) reopen(s).

We have taken your feedback on our online provision very seriously and developed a new online teaching protocol that we will share with you should we have to go online.
